

RESOLUTION R1011-35

A RESOLUTION SETTING APPOINTING A MUNICIPAL JUDGE PRO TEMPORE

WHEREAS: Chapter V, Section 21 of the City of Gold Beach City Charter grants the Gold Beach City Council the authority to appoint a municipal judge and specify the term and salary for the appointment; and

WHEREAS: Ordinance 624, Section 3, provides for appointment of a Municipal Judge Pro Tempore in the absence of or the vacancy in the office of Municipal Judge; and

WHEREAS: According to Ordinance 624, appointment of a Municipal Judge Pro Tempore shall be made by resolution of the City Council, which shall designate the duration of the appointment


WHEREAS: Ordinance 624 limits the term of appointment of the City of Gold Beach Municipal Court Judge to no more than one year; and

WHEREAS: Municipal Judge Rod Black is currently compensated for his services at the rate of \$20 per hour; and

NOW THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED: the City Council of the City of Gold Beach appoints Mr. James Fallman as the City of Gold Beach Municipal Court Judge Pro Tempore for one year, the maximum term allowed by Ordinance 624 and sets his compensation at \$20 per hour.


