

NOTICE

The issuance of a sign permit by the City does not ensure compliance with all state requirements. You are encouraged to contact the Oregon Department of Transportation (ODOT) before applying for a permit to install signs, which face as State Highway.

An electrical permit is required from State Building Codes if an electrical installation is made. Electrical permit verification must be submitted to the City of Gold Beach, PRIOR TO FINAL INSPECTION.

A building permit from Curry County may be required for your sign. Verification may be made at the Department of Public Services-Building Division, located downstairs in the Courthouse Annex Building in Gold Beach.

Installation shall be completed not more than 90 days after the permit date. A 45-day extension may be granted if applied for in writing. If the sign is not installed within the times permitted, the permit shall be void. The square foot charge is based on the total sign face area for each property as defined in Section 4.310 (18) of the Gold Beach Business Code.

Gold Beach Sign Code

Section 4.300 of the Gold Beach Sign Code Ordinance addresses applicable criteria relating to the types of signs, size, structure and fees. Please ask for a copy of the code if you have questions.
