TITLE: Resolution R1415-04 Contract Award for 3rd Street Sidewalk Construction

SUMMARY AND BACKGROUND:

This has been a multi-year project. We ran into several unanticipated issues which slowed the project and increased costs, BUT we are finally to the actual sidewalk! What we have completed to date:

- Additional engineering
- Vacation of a portion of a roadway
- Obtain an easement for a portion of the existing roadway
- Relocate the roadway north—had to move water services, driveways, install a catch basin, and repave
- Install new street lights
- Run new electrical underground for lights

We bid the project in two sections in case costs came in over what we projected for the final phase. The most important section was the top of the rise just west of the last year's road relocation to the library. The wanted--but less critical-section was from the Stewart Street intersection east. The bids came in below your projected final cost so we are awarding the bid for the entire length from Stewart Street to the library.

FINANCIAL IMPACT:

The bid is for \$113,331

Dear Jodi:

This letter is to recommend action by the City in response to bids received on September 10, 2014 for the above referenced project. We received five bids. Please see the attached detailed summary of bids which also shows the Engineer's estimate.

We recommend that the City take the following action:

1. Accept all bids.
2. Award a contract to Benny Hempstead Excavating, Inc., the lowest responsive bidder in the amount of \$113,331.00 for the Basic Bid plus Additive Alternate 1, contingent upon no protest being received during the Notice of Intent to Award Protest Period.

It is our opinion that Benny Hempstead Excavating, Inc. has sufficient experience and qualifications to satisfactorily construct the project.

Assuming the Council concurs with our recommendation, we have enclosed three copies of the Notice of Award. A representative for the City needs to sign all three copies after which they should be returned to our office. (*Please do not date the Notice of Award.*) We will date the Award following the Protest Period. Contracts and Performance Bonds will then be forwarded to ~~Ausland Builders, Inc.~~ Benny Hempstead for their signature.

Pursuant to ORS 279C.835, the Oregon Bureau of Labor and Industries requires that Form WH-81 be filled out by the contracting agency and sent to them with a copy of the first-tier subcontractor form, if applicable (ORS 279C.370), within 30 days of issuing the Notice of Award. The form is available at <http://www.oregon.gov/boli/WHD/PWR/docs/wh81.pdf>. The Owner is also responsible for payment of a Public Works Fee to the Bureau of Labor & Industries. RESOLUTION R1415-04

**A RESOLUTION TO AWARD A CONSTRUCTION CONTRACT FOR
3RD STREET SIDEWALK IMPROVEMENTS**

WHEREAS, The City solicited interested bidders for proposed improvements to 3rd Street sidewalks, specifically improving sidewalks from the Stewart Street intersection to the library; and

WHEREAS, Five individual bidders submitted bids for consideration for the project; and

WHEREAS, According to ORS 279C.375 (1), the City of Gold Beach is required to award the contract to the lowest responsive bidder; and

WHEREAS, Benny Hempstead Excavating, Inc. submitted the lowest responsible bid for the project with a bid of \$113,331; and

WHEREAS, In accordance with ORS 279C.375 (2), the project engineer, the Dyer Partnership Engineers & Planners, Inc., acting on behalf of the City of Gold Beach, notified all bidders of the City's intent to award the contract to Benny Hempstead Excavating, Inc. as the lowest responsible bidder; and

WHEREAS, The project engineer, the Dyer Partnership Engineers & Planners, Inc. has confirmed that Benny Hempstead Excavating, Inc. is the lowest responsible bidder and recommends the City award the contract to Benny Hempstead Excavating, Inc.

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED: the City Council of the City of Gold Beach, awards the construction contract for the 3rd Street Sidewalk Improvements to the lowest responsible bidder, Benny Hempstead Excavating, Inc. and authorizes the City Administrator to execute all documents related to the project.
